ACTIVE DUTY LIST

Contains all regular and reserve officers on active duty.

COMPETITIVE CATEGORIES

Per 10 USC <296><296> 621 and 14005 all officers on the Active-Duty Lists and the Reserve Active-Status List are placed in a competitive category as defined in SECNAVINSTs 1400.1 and 1427.1.

DATE OF BIRTH

The officer's **year** of birth as recorded in BUPERS records.

<>

DATE OF RANK

The date the officer was appointed to a particular grade. Used to determine that officer's rank within the grade

<>

DELAY OF PROMOTION

An officer who is selected for promotion but whose actual promotion to a higher grade has been delayed for any reason may be shown temporarily in a junior position until the officer is actually promoted, at which time the officer's relative precedence will be corrected.

DESIGNATORS

The officer designator codes are four digit numbers used to group officers by categories for administrative purposes. These codes identify, through the first three digits, the categories in which the officers are appointed and/or designated, and, through the fourth digit, the status of the officers within the various categories.

ENSIGNS

Ensigns are not assigned precedence numbers until promoted to Lieutenant (junior grade). Therefore the register number of most ensigns will be blank. Ensigns with the same date of rank rank among themselves in alphabetical order.

<>

ERRORS OR OMISSIONS

Due to unavailability of some data at the time of publication some data fields may be blank. Some errors can occur in automated data information entry and processing. Some names are not complete due to data processing limitation. Errors or omissions should be reported in writing as follows: Active duty to Pers-85, Reserves to Pers-86, retired officers to NRPC Code N31. Users should use the form included with this publication, activated by selecting "survey" from the menus.

FLAG OFFICER LISTS

Separate lists containing all flag officers on active duty and all reserve flag officers. A combined list is also available.

FROCKED OFFICERS

The grade of frocked officers is their current permanent (not frocked) grade. For guidance on frocking policy contact Pers-85 or Pers-86.

GRADE

Officer grades are specified in Title 10 United States Code.

HIGHEST GRADE

This indicates, for a regular officer, the highest grade in which the officer served on active duty prior to original retirement, for a reserve officer, the highest grade attained in the Naval Reserve prior to original retirement.

HONORS & CEREMONIES

In matters involving honors, ceremonies, or preferences precedence shall be given to retired officers who served on active duty in the grade in which retired, vis-a-vis retired officers of the same grade holding that grade on the retired list by virtue of a combat citation promotion.

INACTIVE STATUS LIST

(10 USC <296>10152)

Contains all reserve officers in
an Inactive Status.

OFFICERS SELECTED FOR PROMOTION

Register numbers were effected on the date of
publication. Officers having a date of rank on or
after the publication date may not appear in the higher
grade.

PAY ENTRY BASE DATE

Pay Entry Base Date is the date which reflects all
service for pay purposes. In the case of medical and
dental officers, the date includes any portion of medical
school and internship or dental school while not a member
of the armed forces.

PRIVACY ACT

The Privacy Act precludes publication of
Social Security Numbers.

REGISTER NUMBER, ALL OFFICERS

The register Number assigned is the number which indicates the officer's relative seniority on the Active-Duty Lists or on the Reserve Active Status List.

The Active-Duty List register number is the lineal number. The Reserve Active-Status list register number is the precedence number.

Lineal numbers are assigned per SECNAVINST 1427.2 according to seniority as determined by the promotion history card, maintained by Pers-85. Precedence numbers are assigned according to seniority as determined by the promotion history card, maintained by Pers-86. All register numbers contain eight places, the first six places are considered the whole number, the final two places the sub-number. Use of the sub-number allows additions and changes to the list without renumbering the entire list.

TAR officers are assigned both lineal numbers and precedence numbers.

Officers on the Retired and the Inactive-Status Lists are not assigned register numbers.

REGISTER NUMBERS, FLAG OFFICERS

Flag officers are assigned register numbers in order of seniority taking into consideration the seniority of both active-duty list and reserve active-status list officers.

Register numbers are established annually in October. When an officer is promoted the officer receives a new number with a sub-number indicating their precedence in the new grade.

REGISTER NUMBER, RESERVE OFFICERS

The first digit of Reserve Active-Status List numbers for officers in grades above the grade of CW-4 indicates the current grade as follows:

REGISTER NUMBER, RESERVE WARRANTS

The first digit of Reserve Active-Status List numbers for officers in grades CW-4 through W-1 indicates a warrant grade, the second indicates the current grade as follow:

RESERVE ACTIVE STATUS LIST

(10 USC 14002)

Contains all reserve officers in an active status. This list also includes officers on active duty in the Training, Administration and Recruiting of the Reserve (TAR) Program.

RETIRED LIST

(10 USC <296>12744)

Contains all retired regular and reserve officers, with and without pay, and all officers on the Temporary Disability Retired List.

RETIREMENT TYPE

This code indicates the retirement type.

<>

SENIORITY

Relative seniority is determined by comparing:
first,

1) Current grade, if the current grade is the same:
compare

2) Date of rank, if Date of rank is the same:
compare

3) Register Number

Example: The officer with register number 064405-70 is junior to the officer with register number 064400-00, and senior to the officer with register number 064405-80.

SOURCE CODE

The Source Code indicates the procurement program under which the officer qualified for current appointment.

<>

SPOT PROMOTIONS

Active duty list officers who are temporarily appointed to the grade of Lieutenant Commander under 10 USC <296>5721 are listed in the grade of Lieutenant.

TAR OFFICER LIST

Contains all officers in the Training, Administration and Recruiting of the Reserve (TAR) Program.

<>

TEMPORARY DISABILITY RETIRED LIST

(10 USC <296>1376)

Contains all regular and reserve officers retired under 10 USC CH 61. This list is in the nature of a "pending" list for all members who, through the process of medical procedures, have been found to be temporarily unable to perform the duties of their grade, and who, according to medical principles, may be permanently disabled.

UNIT IDENTIFICATION CODE (UIC)

A five digit code which identifies the command to which the officer is assigned.

<>

WARRANT OFFICER ACTIVE DUTY LIST

(10 USC <296>574)

Contains all regular and reserve warrant officers on active duty.

YEAR GROUP

The Year Group is the fiscal year in which an officer is commissioned as an ensign. It is used only for active duty and TAR officers. For those officers who are not commissioned as ensigns, a constructive year group applicable to their contemporaries is assigned.

<>

ZONES

The zone data field displays the following data:

ABOVE: An officer who is above zone in the current fiscal year.

IN: An officer who is in zone in the current fiscal year.

BELOW: An officer who is eligible for below zone consideration in the current fiscal year.

NO: An officer who is not eligible for consideration for promotion in the current fiscal year.

n/a: An officer for whom zone information is not applicable in the current fiscal year.
For example: Ensigns.

"bland": An officer for whom zone data was not computed in this edition of the register. (Flags, Capts.)
